- *Sons of God & daughters of Men
 - *3 views
 - * Sons of God were Fallen Angels
 - * Sons of God were demon possessed
 - * Sons of God were Seth's sons and daughters were from Cain

*The Judgment and Noah Sons of God & Daughters of Man

- *The Ark
 - * Made out of gopher wood
 - *Covered inside and outside with pitch
 - *Length = 300 cubits (450 feet)
 - * Width = 50 cubits (75 feet)
 - * Height = 30 cubit (45 feet)
 - * Football field is 360 feet by 160 feet
 - * One door and one window
 - * Contents 8 humans, birds, land animals and food

*The Judgment and Noah The Ark

- *God commands Noah, his family and animals to go in the Ark
- *God shuts them in (Genesis 7:16)
- *Wait in the Ark for seven days (Genesis 7:10)
- *Rained 40 days and nights (Genesis 7:12)
- *Water stayed on the earth for 150 days (Genesis 7:24)

*Extermination & Preservation (Genesis 7)

- * Matthew 6:
- * 25: Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing?
- * 26: Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?
- * 27: Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?
- * 28: "So why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin;
- * 29:and yet I say to you that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.
- * 30:Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith?
- * 31: "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'
- * 32: For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.
- * 33: But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
- * 34: Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day *is* its own trouble.
